Use It



Norfolk and Suffolk ICS is a group of health and care services in **Norfolk** and **Suffolk**. This includes **GPs, hospitals and social services**. They help people get the care they need.



Secondary use of data means using your information, but **not for direct care**, like an appointment. Instead it helps plan NHS services and improve care for people.



A **Privacy Notice** tells you what information is collected and how it's used. It explains how your information is kept safe. Each organisation has a privacy notice to follow.



Your **information** is protected by UK law. Only **staff who are allowed** can see it. Information is kept safe and used to make care better for everyone.



The **Norfolk and Suffolk Data Hub** is a safe place where the NHS keeps and uses information. It combines information from ICS group members. Only authorised health and care staff can access it.



Your information helps us to understand local health needs, **improve care** and find people who need extra support.



Your personal information includes **medical conditions** and **care plans**. It is linked with information from other health and care services to help provide the right care and support when you need it.



Your personal information is **hidden** and cannot be seen unless your health care service want to **offer you care**. You can see, change and limit what information you share. You can choose not to share your information for research.
