What is the Dynamic Support Register?



The Dynamic Support Register is for people with a Learning Disability and Autism or both.

It helps professionals to know who might need extra support.

It helps to support people at home.

How does the Dynamic Support Register help?



It helps the people supporting you to work together.

If you are on the Dynamic Support Register, professionals will make sure your care is regularly reviewed by everyone working with you.

It helps you to get the right care and treatment at home whenever possible.

It helps you get the right support as fast as possible if you ever need it.

What information will be held on the Dynamic Support Register?

Usually it will include information about:

- your name, birthday and NHS number.
- your health, including your mental health.
- where you live and who you live with.
- anything that people involved in providing your care and support should know to keep you and them safe.

What happens if I need to go to hospital?



Sometimes people need to go to hospital to get the help they need.

The Dynamic Support Register will help people who are working with you to make a plan to help you to move back to the community with the support you need.

What happens if I am not on the Dynamic Support Register?



It is your choice whether you want to be added to the dynamic support register.

If you do not want to be added, people working with you will still give you support if you need it.



Being on the register means that more services will know about your needs.

If services are aware of your needs, they will be able to make a support plan more quickly in an emergency
