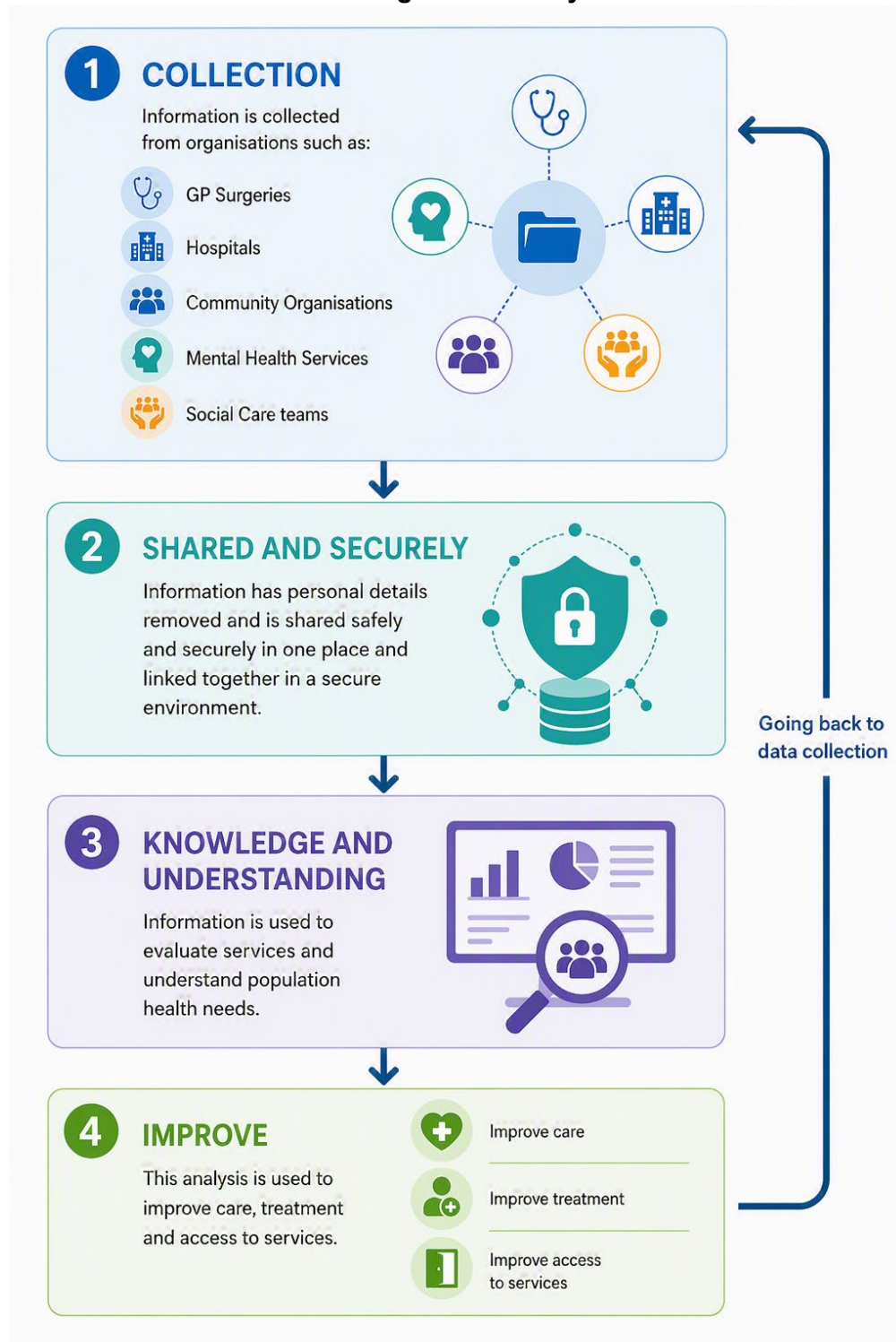


Your Data Hub – an overview of how your data is used

The Data Hub serves as a secure and centralised library of information about local people's use of health and care services. This data has personal details removed and is held securely in the UK.

In this document, you will find a brief overview of how your information is collected and used. For full details, please read the Data Hub Privacy Notice, which contains information about the data we collect and hold about you, why we have it, how we look after it and who we might share it with.

Information flow within the Integrated Care System



- Your information is collected from health and care services such as GPs, A&E attendances and home visits.
- It is securely transferred and personal identifiers removed.
- It is used to gain insights to support population health, evaluation of services, demand for services, quality of services, health outcomes, length of waiting list to see where improvements can be made.
- This helps us to ensure we have the right services in the right areas that are meeting your needs.
- Information is shared back to organisations providing and supporting health and social care.
- If a health and care professional wants to offer a group of patients further care to help prevent illness occurring, they will request your details so they can offer care.

Your Rights

UK legislation and NHS England give the NHS the right to use this information for purposes such as commissioning, population health and service design requirements. You cannot be identified by the Data Hub analysts.
